

GENERAL BUSINESS CLIMATE



- 1. In order to encourage FDI, a paradigm shift is needed from the 'Made in Hungary' approach towards the 'Invented in Hungary' paradigm, in accordance with the Government's strategy. The Chamber supports the Government's strategy and offers consultation in the development of the regulatory environment required for the paradigm shift.
- 2. The Chamber advocates for maintaining a competitive and predictable tax regime.
- 3. The Chamber recommends that the Government should promote a more balanced industrial portfolio.

COMPETITIVE WORKFORCE

- 4. The Government shall support the **extension and widening of labour market supply**, in order to provide current and future investors the required workforce pool.
- 5. Creating a **clear concept** for the recognition and **integration of corporate-established training programs** is recommended.
- 6. AmCham recommends the revision of the training aid system, allowing more companies to access it.
- 7. AmCham recommends to allow corporations to **support educational institutions directly** with part of their **vocational training contribution.**
- 8. AmCham recommends that **the dual education and the dual vocational training programs** receive **equal** recognition and **support**.
- 9. We suggest that the Government allocates **significant support and budget for the transformation of the education system**, focused on developing key competencies and securing a competitive workforce.
- 10. We recommend effective actions to extend the digital labour market.
- 11. We suggest the revision and the **improvement** of the Hungarian system of **occupational medical care.**

RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT AND INNOVATION



- 12. The Chamber advocates for the **support** of **high value added manufacturing and services**, and the promotion of product and service innovation.
- 13. We recommend a coordinated government approach to stimulate corporate R&D spending and to attract new R&D centers to Hungary.
- 14. AmCham offers its suggestions to the current R&D grant system.
- 15. We recommend the Government to further encourage the **cooperation** between large **corporations**, **universities**, **investors** and **startups**.

DIGITAL ECONOMY



- 16. We support the **introduction of more e-government services** with the aim of reducing bureaucracy. For this, we propose the **adaptation of modern cloud-based ICT technologies** and the creation of supportive legislative background for e-services.
- 17. The Chamber suggests that **decision makers and institutions responsible for the regulation of data protection** and the regulatory environment of the safe usage of data generated at service providers should **act proactively.**
